

INSTALLING AND RUNNING TCLSADIE FOR WINDOWS

1. tclSadie for Windows is freely available by anonymous ftp from server modis.ece.arizona.edu as follows:
Invoke ftp: ftp modis.ece.arizona.edu
User: anonymous
Password: <Use your email account, for example: smith@u.arizona.edu>
Change directory: cd /pub/outgoing/tclSadie
Set type to binary: type binary
Download the file: get WinSadie.exe
Quit ftp: quit
2. WinSadie.exe is a self extracting file. Click on the file from Windows Explorer, and indicate the location where you want the file installed, for example:
selecting C:\ will install the software in C:\WinSadie, or
selecting C:\Program Files will install the software in C:\Program Files\WinSadie.
3. Run tclSadie for Windows by clicking on the file "tclSadie.exe" from Windows Explorer. You may create a shortcut icon for the desktop, or add it to your "Start" menu, as you would for any Windows application.

DOCUMENTATION AND HELP

1. No documentation for tclSadie for Windows is currently available. Documentation for a similar application "macSadie" is available at: <http://www.ece.arizona.edu/~dial/ece425/MacSADIEman.pdf>
Most of the functions are the same between macSadie and tclSadie for Windows. The .pdf file can be read by Adobe Acrobat Reader 3.0, or later. It is approximately 600kb in size.
