- Students must earn a grade of C or higher in all required ECE courses. These courses are noted with a “*” symbol.
- Students who have already completed MSE 110 or Chem 152 may use it towards a Technical Elective.
- CE students must complete 7 Technical Electives. A minimum of 4 Technical Electives must be ECE courses. Remaining Technical Electives can be upper-division courses related to your major (e.g., math, physics, engineering, technology) or ECE courses.
- Students must declare advanced standing status between their sophomore and junior semesters in order to take 300-level engineering courses.
